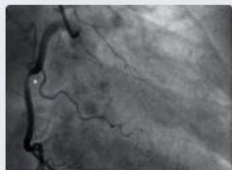

Atrial Fibrillation

It is a common arrhythmia caused by uncoordinated atrial activation and usually an irregular ventricular response.

MANAGEMENT

Thromboembolic Prophylaxis in Atrial Fibrillation

The risk of thromboembolism can be reduced by an appropriate use of antithrombotic therapy but at an increased risk of bleeding.

PROCEDURE

Cardioversion of Atrial Fibrillation

Cardioversion can be performed pharmacologically or electrically to restore normal sinus rhythm in patients with atrial fibrillation.

Overview and Recommendations

Background

- Atrial fibrillation (AF) is a common supraventricular tachyarrhythmia caused by uncoordinated atrial activation and associated with an irregularly irregular ventricular response.
- Causes of atrial fibrillation include an underlying structural heart disease, metabolic disorders, endocrine diseases, and certain medications.
- The prevalence of AF is approximately 1%-2% in the general population of developed countries.
- Definitions of AF:
 - Paroxysmal AF is recurrent atrial fibrillation that terminates spontaneously, lasting possibly up to 7 days, but usually < 48 hours.
 - Persistent AF is atrial fibrillation that is sustained > 7 days or requires termination by cardioversion.
 - Longstanding persistent AF is atrial fibrillation that is persistent for > 1 year.
 - Permanent AF refers to atrial fibrillation where the patient and physician agree to stop additional attempts to restore normal sinus rhythm because atrial fibrillation cannot be converted anymore.

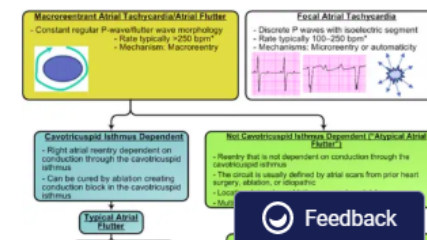

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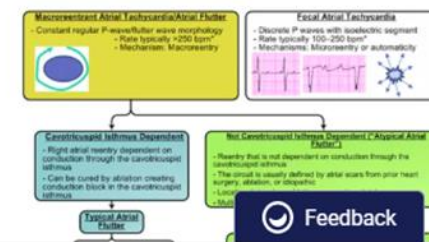

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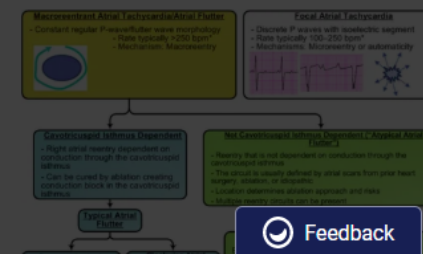
